Welcome to Cullinan Park, a 754-acre green oasis in Sugar Land, TX blessed with a rich diversity of habitat, plants & wildlife. The City of Sugar Land annexed the park in 2016 after an Inter-local Agreement was developed between Sugar Land, the City of Houston, Houston Parks Board & Cullinan Park Conservancy. Since then, the Park has experienced a renewal. Improvements include a restroom, new trails, signage and other beautification, with more improvements planned. These are partially funded by the Cullinan Park Conservancy, a non-profit formed by citizens committed to enhancing & protecting the park's natural beauty. The Conservancy is focused on implementing the Master Plan, funding capital improvements and bringing our community and nature together.

Cullinan is a haven for birding with frontage on Oyster Creek & Red Gully as well as White Lake & Pumpkin Lake. Enjoy miles of trails winding through shady forests, meadows & wetlands. Local birders begin by checking the pier and observation tower. Then they take to the trails. To the east of White Lake, a .33 mile accessible trail leads to an observation platform. Beyond that, the trail takes you past historic Hodge's Bend Cemetery & around the lake. Or start with the Green Trail and explore a network of trails lacing through hardwood forests & along Oyster Creek. This list includes 252 species of birds & counting. Thanks to the eBird listers for supplying the checklist data.
