

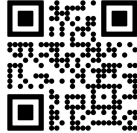

free CABIN, COFFEE, CONVERSATION

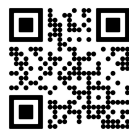

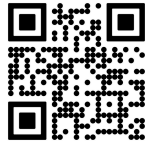
